Jesus Resisted Temptation

MATTHEW 4:1-11

Jesus answered with Scripture. He said, "It is written that people need more than bread. People need every word that comes from the mouth of God."

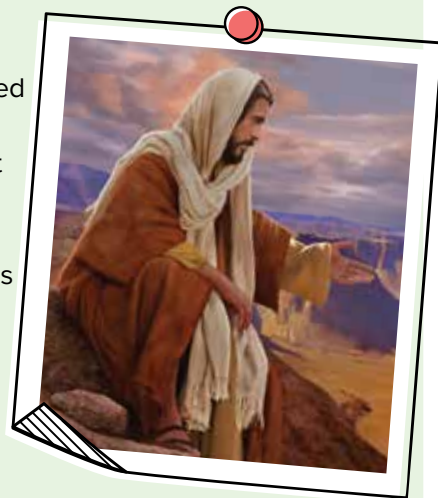
