Make the sound of an animal God made that flies.


Act like you are swimming while you name something God made that lives in water.

## God Created the World

### GENESIS 1:1–2:3

Day 1: At first, there was nothing. Then, God began to work. He said, “Let there be light!” God spoke the words, and light appeared! He called the light *day* and the dark *night*. God saw that it was good.

Day 2: God commanded for space to separate the waters to make the sky. He spoke the words and the sky appeared!

Day 3: God said, “Let the water gather in one place. Let dry land appear.” God spoke the words, and it happened. He called the land *earth*. He called the waters *seas*. God saw that it was good. God said, “Let the earth grow plants and fruit trees.” God spoke, and it happened.

Day 4: God said, “Let there be lights in the sky.” God spoke and it happened. The sun, moon, and stars appeared. God saw that it was good.

Day 5: Then God filled the water with fish and water animals. He filled the sky with birds of all kinds. God saw all that He made was good.

Day 6: God made land animals first. Then God made the first people. He made people in His image. God told the people to take care of the earth and its animals. God saw all He had made. It was very good.

Day 7: God rested from His work. He made the seventh day a holy day because He finished His work.
